




Selective Service Progress Report

Federal law requires virtually all young men living in the U.S. to register with Selective Service within 30 days of their 18th birthday.

Benefits linked to Selective Service registration:

- Student financial aid
- Federal job training
- Federal jobs
- Citizenship for immigrants
- Additional benefits according to individual state laws
